

Hebrews cont. 4

Heb 7:1-10 Review of Abraham & Melchizedek
 Gen 14:18 note (or) The LORD is known to a Gentile King, Melchizedek also Daniel - the books of Gentile Prophecy

Heb 7:1 For this Melchizedek, King of Salem, priest of the Most High GOD, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him.

CHRIST a High Priest Forever

Heb 8 New Covenant Summary also Note

Heb 8:10 For this is the Covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the LORD; I will put MY laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a GOD, and they shall be to ME a people:

Heb 8:11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for all shall know ME, from the least to the greatest.

Heb 9:1-5 The Jewish Tabernacle and its utensils are described.

Hebrews cont. 5
 Heb 9:6-14 CHRIST through HIS OWN Blood overcomes the earthly tabernacle. The veil to the HOLY as HOLIES is shown to allow Believers a Relationship with GOD.

Heb 9:15 CHRIST is the Mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the First Testament, they which are called might receive the Promise of Eternal Inheritance.

Heb 9:28 So CHRIST was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for HIM shall HE appear the Second Time without sin unto salvation.

Heb 10 Burned offerings cannot remove sin
 Heb 10:12 But this man (JESUS) after HE had offered One Sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the Right Hand of GOD;

Heb 10:13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made HIS footstool.

Heb 10:14 For by One Offering HE hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

Heb 11 FAITH

Heb 11:1 Now FAITH is the substance of things Hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Heb 11:1-3 FAITH has always been the mark of GOD's servants, from the beginning.

Heb 11:1-39 Bible examples of FAITH

Heb 11:4-7 It is set forth by instances from Abel to Noah.

Heb 11:6 But without FAITH it is impossible to please HIM: for he that cometh to GOD must Believe that HE IS, and that HE is a rewarder of them that diligently seek HIM.

Heb 11:8-19 FAITH by Abraham & his descendants

Heb 11:20-31 By Jacob, Joseph, Moses, the Israelites, and Rahab.

Heb 11:32-38 By other Old Testament Believers

Heb 12:5... MY son despise not thou the chastening of the LORD, nor saint when thou art rebuked of HIM:

Heb 12:6 For whom the LORD Loveth HE chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom HE receiveth

Heb 12:7 If ye endure chastening, GOD dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the Father chasteneth not?

Heb 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

Heb 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have; for HE hath said, I will never leave thee nor forsake thee.

Heb 13:6 So that we may boldly say, The LORD is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

Heb 13:8 JESUS CHRIST, the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever!
