

Hebrews

Heb 1:2 GOD hath in these last days spoken unto us by HIS SON, whom HE hath appointed all things, by whom also HE made the world.

Heb 1:3 ... set down on the right hand of the Majesty, on high;

1:4 Being made so much better than the angels, to HE both by inheritance obtained a more excellent name than they.

Heb 1:5 ... sit on my right hand, until I make this enemies thy footstool.

Heb 1:6 ~~Jesus Christ~~ See above the Angels

Heb 1:4 Summary (note) of Angels

Heb 2:9 But we are JESUS, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that HE by the grace of GOD should taste death for every man.

Heb 2:11 For both HE that sanctifieth and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause HE is not ashamed to call them brethren.

2:12 Saying, I will declare thy name unto my brother, in the midst of the Church will I sing

praise unto thee.

Heb 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are parts of flesh and blood, HE also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil.

2:15 And deliver them up; though fear of death we all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Heb 6:20 JESUS, high priest - Melchisedec

Gen 14:18 note (a) The LORD is known to a Gentile King, → Melchizedek Daniel - the book of Gentile Prophecy

Heb 8:8 note 8 Covenants

Heb 8:10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel, after those days, said the LORD; I will put my laws into their minds, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a GOD, and they shall be to me a people:

Heb 8:11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.

Heb 9:15 CHRIST is the mediator of the New Testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the First Testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

Heb 9:28 By CHRIST was one offered to bear the sins of many, and unto them that look for HIM shall HE appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

Heb 10 Burnt offering, incense & remove sin.

Heb 10:12 But this man (JESUS), after HE had offered sacrifice for sins for ever, set down a thought hand of GOD;

10:13 From henceforth inflicting till his enemies be made his footstool.

10:14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified?

Hebrews 5 cont.

Heb 2:17 Wherefore in all things it behoved HIM to be made like unto HIS brother, that HE might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to GOD, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

2:18 For in that HE himself hath suffered being tempted, HE is able to succor them that are tempted.

Heb 3:17 unbelief causes one to depart from the Living GOD

⇒ 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief

Heb 4 Better Rest for the believer

Heb 4:9-10 Therefore remaineth therefore a rest to the people of GOD.

⇒ 4:10 For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as GOD did from HIS.

Heb 4:12 For the word of GOD is quick and powerful...

It entereth and is a discerner of the thoughts and intent of the heart.

Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest, that is passed into the heavens, JESUS the SON OF GOD, let us hold fast our profession.

Heb 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feelings of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin.

Heb 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find Grace, to help in time of need.

Heb 5 CHRIST a high priest of order of Melchisedec

Heb 11:1 Now Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

⇒ Heb 11:1-39 Bible example of Faith

Heb 12:6 For whom the LORD loveth HE chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom HE receiveth.

Heb 13:2 Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

Heb 13:3 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have; for HE hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

13:6 So let us now boldly say, 'The LORD is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.'
