

Little Book | Revelation | cont. 8

Rev 10:1-2 And I saw Another Mighty Angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud; and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face as it were the sun and his feet as pillars of fire: And he had in his hand a little book open:

Rev 10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roareth: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

Rev 10:4 And when the 7 thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Seal up those things which the 7 thunders uttered, and write them not.

Rev 11:3 And I will give power unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred threescore days, clothed in sackcloth (42 months)

Rev 11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in their day of prophecy; and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the earth with all plagues, as often as they will.
