

Revelation cont. 12

Rev 13:1 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having 7 heads and 10 horns, and upon his horns 10 crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

Rev 13:2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

Rev 13:3-4 the beast is wounded and healed

Rev 13:5-6 the beast gives power 42 months

Rev 13:6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against GOD.

Rev 13:7 And it was given unto him to walk with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues and nations.

Rev 13:8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the LAMB slain from the foundation of the world.

Rev 13:9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

Rev 13:11-15 a second beast from the earth

Rev 13:16 And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads

Rev 13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is six hundred threescore and six.

Revelation cont. 13

Rev 14:1 And I looked, and lo, a LAMB stood on the mount Zion, and with him an hundred ~~thousand~~ forty and four thousand, having his FATHER'S name written in their foreheads.

Rev 14:2 ... and I heard the voice of harps harping with their harps:

Rev 14:3 And they sang as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts and the elders and no man could learn that song but the 144,000, which were redeemed from the earth.

Rev 14:4 ... These are they which follow the LAMB whithersoever HE goeth, these were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto GOD and unto the LAMB.

Rev 14:6 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people.

Rev 14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear GOD, and give glory to HIM, for the hour of HIS judgment is come: and worship HIM that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters

Rev 14:9 And the 3rd angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of GOD... and he shall be tortured with sire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the LAMB.

Revelation cont. 14

Rev 14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of GOD, and the faith of JESUS

Rev 14:14-20 Vision of Arma geddon

Rev 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvellous, seven angels having the seven last plagues, for in them is filled up the wrath of GOD.

Rev 15:2 ... and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of GOD.

Rev 15:3 And they sing the song of Moses the servant of GOD, and the song of the LAMB, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, just and true are thy ways, thou KING of saints.

Rev 15:4 ... for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.

Rev 15:6 And the 7 angels came out of the temple having the 7 plagues...

15:7 And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials, full of the wrath of GOD, who liveth for ever & ever.

Rev 15:8 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of GOD, and from HIS power: and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the 7 plagues were fulfilled.

Revelation cont. 15

Rev 16:1 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of GOD upon the earth.

Rev 16:2 And the first angel poured out his vial upon the earth: and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.

Rev 16:3 And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea: and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.

Rev 16:4 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters: and they became blood.

Rev 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O LORD, what art and wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus.

Rev 16:7 And I heard another voice out of the altar say, Even so, LORD GOD ALMIGHTY, true and righteous are thy judgments.

Rev 16:8 And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun: and power was given to him to scorch men with fire.

Rev 16:10 And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast: and his kingdom was full of darkness: and they gnawed their tongues for pain.

Rev 16:12 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates: and the water thereof was drawn up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.
