

## Seven Seals [Revelation] cont. 4

Rev 6:2 1st Seal And I saw and behold a white horse ... and he went forth conquering and to conquer.

Rev 6:4 2nd Seal And there went out another horse that was red and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth.

Rev 6:6 3rd Seal a black horse who brought Famine

Rev 6:8 4th Seal And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. and they brought Death.

Rev 6:9-10 5th Seal I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of GOD.

Rev 6:12-17 6th Seal ... and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; 6:13 And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth...

## Rev 7 The Great Tribulation - a Period of Salvation

Rev 7:1 And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the LIVING GOD: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

Rev 7:3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, tell me, have sealed the servants of our GOD in their foreheads.

Rev 7:4 And I found the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed 144,000 of all the tribes of ISRAEL.

## [Revelation] cont. 6

Rev 8:8 And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood.

Rev 8:9 And the third part of the waters, which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

Rev 8:10 And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;

Rev 8:11 and the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.

Rev 8:12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

Rev 8:13 ... an angel flying through the midst of heaven saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the three angels yet to sound.

Rev 9:1 And the 5th angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from Heaven into the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

Rev 9:2 And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit.

Rev 9:3 And there came out of the smoke locusts upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power.

## [Revelation] cont. 5

Rev 7:9 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the LAMB, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

Rev 7:10 And with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our GOD which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the LAMB.

Rev 7:13-14 ... what are these which are arrayed in white robes? and where came they?

7:14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the LAMB.

Rev 7:15 They shall hunger no more...

7:17 For the LAMB which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them into living fountains of waters: and GOD shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.

Rev 8:2 And I saw the seven angels which stood before GOD:

Rev 8:6 And the seventh angel which had the sixth trumpet prepared himself to sound.

Rev 8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up.

## [Revelation] cont. 7

Rev 9:4 And it was commanded them that they should... hurt not ... only those men which have not the seal of GOD in their foreheads.

1st Woe Rev 9:5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented 5 months.

Rev 9:6-10 ... Locusts were like unto horses prepared for battle...

Rev 9:11 And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon (Destroyer).

Rev 9:13 And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before GOD,

9:14 Saying to the 6th Angel which had the trumpet, Loose the 4 Angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

9:15 And the four angels were loosed ... to slay the third part of men.

9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them.

9:17 ... and the heads of the horsemen were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire, and smoke, and brimstone.

9:18 By these 3 was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone which issued out of their mouths.

9:20 And the rest of the men not killed, repented not.
