

[Exodus] cont 16

Ex33:9 And it came to pass, as Moses entered unto the tabernacle, the cloudy pillar descended, and stood at the door of the tabernacle, and the LORD talked with Moses.

Ex33:11 And the LORD spake unto Moses face to face as a man speaketh unto his friend...

Ex33:12-23 Moses desires to see the Glory of GOD.

Ex33:20 And HE said, thou canst not see MY face: for there shall no man see ME and live.

Ex33:21 And the LORD said, Behold, there is a place by ME, and thou shalt stand upon a rock. (of FAITH)

Ex33:22 And it shall come to pass while MY GLORY passeth by, that I will put thee in a cliff of the rock, and I will cover thee with MY hand while I pass by:

Ex33:23 And I will take away mine hand and thou shalt see MY Back Parts: but MY Face shall not be seen.

Ex36 Bezaleel and Aholiab chosen by the LORD for work on the Tabernacle. The work is begun.

Ex37 The ark and alter are constructed

Ex38 Construction of Sanctuary continues

Ex38:26 The number of men who were 20 years old and above: 603,550.

Ex39 The holy garments for Aaron.

Ex39:43 And Moses did look upon all the work, and, behold, they had done it as the LORD commanded, even so had they done it: and Moses blessed them.

Ex40:1-2 April 1, of the second year, The Tabernacle is set up.

Ex40:3 And thou shalt put therein the Ark of the Testimony, and cover the Ark with the Vail.

Ex40:34-38 The Glory of the LORD fills the Tabernacle.

Ex40:35-37 The Cloud of the Glory of the LORD rested on the Tabernacle, and Israel traveled not. When it was taken up, they traveled.

[Exodus] cont 17

Ex34:10-27 GOD's Covenant and Festivals

Ex34:27 And the LORD said unto Moses, Write thou these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with thee and with Israel.

Ex34:28 And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And HE wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the Ten Commandments. Ex31:18

Ex34:29-35 Moses face shined after being in the presence of the GLORY of GOD. He wore a vail when speaking with men.

Ex34:34 But when Moses went in before the LORD to speak with HIM, he took the vail off, until he came out. And he came out, and spake unto the children of Israel that which he was commanded.

Ex35 Moses reminds the people of the Sabbath and asks them to make an offering unto the LORD, of all the things needed for the Tabernacle and the ark of the Covenant.

[Exodus] cont. 19

Ex40:38 For the Cloud of the LORD was upon the Tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.
