Lev 24:22 Ye shall have one manner of law as well for the stranger, as for one of your own country: for I AM the LORD your GOD.

Lev 25:1-7 The sabbath of rest for the land in the seventh year.

X Lev 25:8-22 50th year a Jubilee. Trumpets sound on the Day of Atonement.

Lev 25:23-34 Redemption of Land and Houses, returned to original owners.

Lev 25:35-38 Compassion towards the poor.

Lev 25:39-55 Bondmen and servants are freed during Jubilee.

Lev 25:55 For unto ME the children of Israel are servants; they are MY servants whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: I AM the LORD your GOD.
