

Numbers

10-20-17

Num 1:46 Even all they that were numbered were six hundred thousand and three thousand and five hundred and fifty.

✗ Num 1 The number of males twenty years and above : 603,550.

⇒ Num 1:47 But the Levites after the tribe of their fathers were not numbered among them.

Num 1:50 But thou shalt appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of testimony...

Num 1:53 But the Levites shall pitch round about the Tabernacle of Testimony...

Num 2 The tribes pitch their tents around the tabernacle of the testimony, by tribe, in a certain order.

Num 3:1-13 The Levites taken for the LORD in place of the firstborn of Israel.

Num 3:13 On the day the LORD smote the firstborn of Egypt, the firstborn of Israel were hallowed to the LORD.

Num 3:39 The Levites numbered : 22,000.

Num 3:43 The firstborn males of Israel: 22,273.

Num 4 The duties of the Levites

Num 4:43 Levites from 30 to 50 years of age served in the Tabernacle

Numbers cont.

Num 4:4-15 The sons of Kohath responsible for the care of the most holy items in the tabernacle.

Num 4:48 Even those that were numbered of them, were eight thousand and five hundred and four score.

Num 5:11-31 The law of jealousies ^{wives & husbands}

Num 6 The law concerning Nazarites

Num 6:2-21 The process and keeping of a Vow by a Nazarite.

⇒ Num 6:22-27 Blessings of the LORD.
The priests are instructed in the proper way to offer blessings unto the people.

Num 7 The Tabernacle and the Altar are dedicated by the offerings provided by the Princes of the Twelve Tribes of Israel.

Num 8 Aaron lights the Lamps of the Sanctuary and the Consecration of the Levites, and their service.

⇒ Num 8:18 And I have taken the Levites for all the firstborn of the children of Israel.

⇒ Num 9 The Passover is kept. The Israelites travelled when the CLOUD was lifted up from the Tabernacle and rested when the CLOUD descended upon the Tabernacle.

Numbers cont. 2

Num 10 The LORD tells Moses to make Two Trumpets of Silver to be used to bring the people to Assembly.

Num 11 The people complain and ask for meat.

Num 11:4-9 Moses complains of his charge.

⇒ Num 11:16 And the LORD said unto Moses, gather unto ME Seventy Men of the Elders of Israel.

✗ Num 11:17 And I will talk with thee there: and I will take of the Spirit which is upon thee, and will put it upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear it not thyself alone.

Num 11:31-35 Quails are given to the people.

Num 12:1 Miriam and Aaron speak against Moses.

Num 12:9 And the anger of the LORD was kindled against them, and HE departed.

⇒ Num 12:8 The LORD chooses to speak to Moses face to face, not in a dream as to others who are prophets.

Num 12:10-15 The LORD punishes Miriam with leprosy.

⇒ Num 13:1-20 Twelve men, one from each tribe, are sent to search the land of Canaan

Numbers cont 3

Num 13:25 The men return from Canaan after searching for Forty Days.

Num 13:27 They report a land that floweth with milk and honey.

Num 13:28-33 The men also report a land with walled cities, giants, and are afraid of them.

⇒ Num 13:30 Only Caleb is willing to fight in the name of the LORD.

✗ Num 14:2 And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron...

Num 14:1-4 Joshua and Caleb labor to still the people.

Num 14:5-10 The LORD wants to destroy all the people save Moses, Joshua and Caleb. But, Moses pleads for them all, to save them.

Num 14:33-34 And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years...

✗ After the number of days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year...

Num 15:16 One law and one manner shall be for you, and for the stranger that sojourneth with you.

⇒ Num 15:38 The Ribband of Blue, the heavenly colour, worn on their garments.

Numbers cont 4

✗ Num 16 The rebellion of Korah, Nathan, and Abiram, and 250 princes' rise up against Moses and Aaron.

Num 16:20-21 And the LORD spoke unto Moses and unto Aaron saying, Separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment.

Num 16:23-30 The LORD tells Moses to command the people to separate themselves from Korah, Dathan, Abiram, and the 250 princes

Num 16:32 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their houses, and all the men that appertained unto Korah, and all their goods.

Num 16:35 And there came out a fire from the LORD, and consumed the two hundred and fifty men that offered incense.

✗ Num 16:41-50 The people murmur against Moses and Aaron, and a plague is sent and destroys 14,700 more people.

Num 17:1-7 Twelve rods, one from each tribe, are laid up before the LORD.

Num 17:8-13 Aaron's rod, representing the tribe of Levi, buds, and is kept for a memorial.

Numbers cont 5

Num 18:1-7 The charge of the Levites and the priests.

Num 18:8-19 The priests' portion.

Num 18:20-32 The Levites' portion.

✗ Num 18:21 And, behold, I have given the children of Levi all the tenth in Israel for an inheritance, for their service which they serve, even the service of the tabernacle of the congregation.

✗ Num 19 A Red Heifer, without blemish, is to be sacrificed as a cleansing from sin.

✗ Num 20 Israel complains about lack of water. The LORD tells Moses and Aaron to strike the rock; instead they smote the rock, twice. This was disobedience to the LORD, and they were not allowed to enter the promise land.

Num 20:14-21 Israel is refused passage through Edom. Edom was Esau, brother of Jacob.

Num 20:22-29 Aaron transfers the priest's office to Eleazar, his son, and dies in mount Hor.

Num 21:1-3 The Canaanites destroyed.

Num 21:21-35 Sihon, king of the Amorites and Og, king of Bashan destroyed.

Numbers cont 6

Num 22 The king of Moab, Balak, seeks to get Balaam to prophesy against Israel.

Num 22:9-21 GOD tells Balaam not to go with the men to Balak.

Num 22:22 And GOD's anger was kindled, because he went; and the angel of the LORD stood in the way...

Num 22:23 The ass of Balaam sees the angel of the LORD with his sword drawn and turns aside; and Balaam smote the ass.

Num 22:28 And the LORD opened the mouth of the ass, and she said unto Balaam, What have I done unto thee, that thou hast smitten me these three times?

Num 22:29 And Balaam said unto the ass, because that hast mocked me...

Num 22:31 Then the LORD opened the eyes of Balaam and he saw the angel, with his sword drawn.

Num 22:32-33 The angel tells Balaam that the ass saved him from being killed.

✗ Num 23 Balaam blesses Israel as the LORD commanded him, against Balak

Numbers cont. 7

Num 24 Balaam prophesies the happiness of Israel.

Num 24:10-14 Balak, dismisses Balaam in anger.

Num 24:15-25 Balaam's prophecies.

Num 24:19 Out of Jacob shall come HE that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city.

Num 25 The Israelites enticed by the daughters of Moab and Midian.

✗ Num 25:6-15 Phineas, Eleazar's son, puts Zimri and Cosbi to death, to stop the plague which was upon the children of Israel, for their idolatry.

Num 25:9 And those that died in the plague were twenty and four thousand.

* Num 26:1-51 Numbering of Israel in plains of Moab near Jericho: there were 601,763 Men 20+ in age.

✗ Num 26:64-65 Names of the original men numbered by Moses and Aaron survived, except Caleb the son of Japhaneh and Joshua the son of Nun.

Num 27:1-11 The law of inheritance. The daughters of Manasseh, son of Joseph, receive their inheritance.

Num 27:12-14 Moses warned of his death

Numbers cont. 8

Num 27:15-23 Joshua appointed to succeed Moses.



Num 27:20 And thou shalt put some of thine honor upon him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be obedient.

Num 28 Offerings for daily sacrifice, the sabbath, and annual feasts.

Num 29 Offerings during the Feast of Tabernacles.

Num 30 The Law of Vows

Num 31 Midian is destroyed for turning Israel away from the LORD.

Num 32 The tribes of Reuben, Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh request an inheritance on the east of Jordan. They agree to cross over and fight with the rest of Israel for their land.

Num 33 Summary of the Israelite journeys from Egypt to Jordan

✂ Num 34 Boundaries of Israel. The boundaries of the Promised Land are given.

Num 35 Cities given to the Levites from the land of the other tribes.

⇒ Num 35 Forty eight cities given to Levites of which six were cities of Refuge.

Num 36 Female descendants of Manasseh, of Joseph
